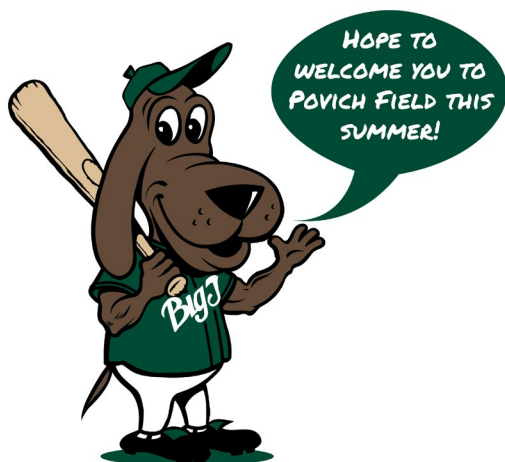






Picnics with the Big Train






What could be better than a picnic dinner and a ballgame with friends this summer?

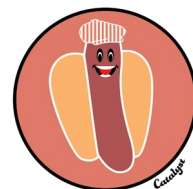

For just \$20* per person, everyone gets a game ticket and a pre-game meal and a drink. Meal choices include:

-  A chicken Caesar salad from Gregorio's Trattoria.

Bethesda Big Train players are elite Division I college baseball players who compete in the summer wooden bat Cal Ripken Collegiate Baseball League. The Big Train has won the league championship eight times since the Ripken League was founded in 2005. In 2011, Perfect Game named the Big Train as the top summer college team in the nation. Sixteen former Big Train players have made it to the major leagues.

Bethesda Community Base Ball Club (BCBBC) is a 501(c)(3) nonprofit community organization with stewardship for the Bethesda Big Train. BCBBC built Shirley Povich Field in partnership with MNCPPC in 1999 to host Big Train games and carry out our charitable purposes. In addition to building Povich Field, BCBBC invested \$600,000 in improving youth baseball and softball fields. Among the many community service initiatives of BCBBC, we have spearheaded the Ripken League's annual food drive that has collected 30 tons of food for the Manna Food Center.

BCBBC has received permission from Montgomery County Government to host 250 fans -- one-third of our capacity of 750 -- in socially distanced pods of two, three, and four fans each. The County has approved our plan for selling food at the ballpark. Except when eating or drinking in the picnic pavilion or in a person's designated seating pod, fans will be required to wear masks.

Shirley Povich Field is located in Cabin John Regional Park, at 10600 Westlake Drive, Rockville. The ballpark is near the intersection of I-270 and the Beltway, very close to Westfield Montgomery. There is ample free parking right near the ballpark.
