They taught me that only about one-third of fans come just for the baseball game. To succeed, a ballclub needs to put on a show every night and give fans a great experience. Mike's dad Bill, baseball's greatest showman, had a fans-first philosophy. The fans adored him.

The best times I have ever had at a ballgame were at Mike Veeck's St. Paul Saints. The baseball is top notch, but it is the fan friendly environment that makes it special. Mike's "Fun Is Good!" approach guides us as we craft the Big Train experience — volunteers welcoming you, Catalyst Hot Dogs, Gregorio's Trattoria, and Bruster's Real Ice Cream, t-shirt giveaways, great music, on-field contests between innings, and visiting sports celebrities.

In addition to watching our boys of summer recapture the Ripken League crown, here's a preview of what we plan to bring you this summer:

- The area behind the first base grandstand will be a **Kids Fun Zone** with moon bounces, games, and prizes.
- Our **Father's Day** game features pre-game catch on the field with dads and their kids.
- Big Train fan favorite and former major leaguer Mike Costanzo, our 2003 MVP, will be in the house Friday June 23.

To enhance the fan experience, we have replaced the 284 seats in the First Base Grandstand and are adding three cameras to improve the quality of our home game broadcasts.

The Bethesda Big Train Summer Baseball Camp returns for its 24th summer of fun and affordable summer baseball for girls and boys ages 5-12. Every kid deserves a great summer. Sign your child up now to be taught by some of America's top college baseball players.

Hall of Fame Big Train Manager Sal Colangelo and Associate Head Coach Galvin Morris will direct the camp. Coaches Sal and Galvin, along with their star-studded Big Train players, will be the instructors, teaching kids the FUNdamentals of baseball. Twenty-one Big Train alumni have made it to the major leagues.

All campers will receive instruction in the fundamentals of the game as well as the opportunity to play in live games. Along with our General Camp, we also offer specialized sessions including Pitching, Catching, and Advanced Development, each of which are for older and more experienced 9-12 year olds looking for more specialized instruction. Every camper will receive an official Big Train Summer Camp t-shirt that will get them free admission to all Big Train home games at Shirley Povich Field during the 2023 regular season. Tickets must be reserved online in advance of each game.

#### **Camp Descriptions**

General Camp for ages 5-12: All campers will receive instruction on basic fundamentals through drills and live games throughout the week. The session is designed for players of all skill levels from beginner to advanced. Campers will work on a mix of drills including bunting, fielding, throwing, hitting and catching, while also playing fun games that help with hand-eye coordination and agility. 9 a.m. to 3 p.m. *June 19 - June 23, June 26 - June 30, July 10 - July 14, July 17 - July 21, and July 24 - July 28.* \$330.


Advanced Development Camp for ages 9-12: This session is designed for kids who play Select or Travel baseball. All campers will receive instruction on the fundamentals as well as more advanced training. Campers will have the chance to play in live games. Campers will work on rundowns, cutoffs, reading the ball off the bat, and baserunning techniques. Campers will participate in competitive games to work on hand-eye coordination and agility. This session is limited to 24 campers. Mornings 9 a.m. to noon. *June 26 - June 30, July 10 - July 14, and July 17 - July 21.* \$260.

**Pitching Camp for ages 9-12:** This session is designed for kids who want to focus specifically on pitching, whether they have been pitching for years or are just now getting started. All campers receive highly specialized training that includes work on stamina, throwing motion, strength and balance. Limited to 24 campers. Pitching Camp will NOT meet on Wednesdays to prevent the risk of campers straining their arms. Campers may attend General Camp on Wednesday afternoon at no additional cost. Afternoons 1 to 3 p.m. Ages 9-12. *June 26 - June 30, July 10 - July 14, and July 17 - July 21.* **\$230**.

Catching Camp for ages 9-12: This session is designed for kids who want to focus specifically on catching, whether they have been catching for years or are just getting started. All campers receive highly specialized training, including work on stance, blocking, throwing, receiving, footwork, and other specific drills. This session is limited to 16 campers. Catching Camp will NOT meet on Wednesdays to prevent the risk of campers straining their arms/bodies. Campers MUST bring their own catcher's equipment. Campers may attend General Camp on Wednesday afternoon at no additional cost. Afternoons 1 to 3 p.m. *June 26 - June 30 and July 10 - July 14.* **\$200**.

# We Are Big Train



Our annual **We Are Big Train campaign** each spring helps provide the Bethesda Community Base Ball Club with the resources we need to support Bethesda Big Train baseball at Shirley Povich Field. It costs about \$350,000 to operate Big Train baseball each year. This includes the obvious uniforms, baseballs, equipment, league fees, and umpires. We have to maintain the quality of Povich Field and compensate our hard working coaches. We operate a summer camp, and we are deeply invested in building a stronger community here in Montgomery County. It all adds up.

While we have a considerable amount of earned income from our summer camp, ticket sales, concessions, souvenirs, and corporate sponsorships, nearly one-quarter of our annual budget and one-half of total spending come from charitable contributions from our supporters. In the last two and one-half years, nearly 350 individuals and families have contributed \$500,000 to help make Big Train baseball at Povich Field so special.

In addition to our annual Base Ball & Holiday Auction held each fall to raise money for our community service initiatives, there are now two other ways Big Train fans can help ensure we are able to maintain the special, fan friendly environment we all love — **We Are Big Train campaign** and our new **David Povich Improvement Fund for Shirley Povich Field**. #### Maintaining the Excellence of Shirley Povich Field

"When I'm here at a Big Train game, I feel like I live in a small town." That's it. That's why we so love Big Train baseball at Shirley Povich Field. As *The Washington Post's* Marc Fisher described it, "In a video game world, this is as retro a summer's eve as most kids will know, and they can't get enough of it."

At a time of increasing social isolation and polarization, we need public spaces where people can come together to relax and have fun. We need places where kids can put away their devices and hang out with their pals for a couple of hours, where seniors can share memories, and where all of us can enjoy the company of others and the rich diversity of our community while we watch our boys of summer.

Big Train baseball at Shirley Povich Field is one of those spaces. Montgomery Parks director Mike Riley says Povich Field, along with the Capital Crescent Trail and Brookside Gardens, is one of the three crown jewels of our parks system. It is up to us to ensure the excellence of Povich Field is maintained for our grandchildren and their children.

### David Povich Improvement Fund for Shirley Povich Field

On Saturday June 3, Big Train baseball will dedicate the First Base Grandstand at Shirley Povich Field in memory of David Povich. David, an accomplished lawyer, a great Washingtonian, an avid baseball fan, and a loyal supporter of Big Train baseball, died in August of 2022. Our Bethesda Community Base Ball Club established the **David Povich Improvement Fund for Shirley Povich Field**. With support from David's friends and family as well as donations from Big Train fans, we have already raised more than \$125,000 to help maintain the excellence of Povich Field long into the future.


